LOCAL RULES

1. Play from beautification areas near teeing area on holes 1 & 9 defined by artificial rocks is prohibited. Relief **must** be taken under rule 25-1 without penalty.
2. All public roadways are deemed to be out of bounds and any ball that crosses over a public road is out of bounds.
3. If a ball is lost in a water hazard (Hole #12) the player may proceed under Rule 26 or as an additional option, drop a ball under penalty of 1 stroke in the dropping zone. All other water hazards are played as lateral (holes #1, #8, #9 & #18).
4. Balls striking the overhead power line on hole #4 tee box, **must** be replayed without penalty.
5. Protection of young trees identified by a stake. If such a tree interferes with a player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the ball must be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 24-2b (Immovable Obstruction). If the ball lies in a water hazard, the player must lift and drop the ball in accordance with Rule 24-2b(i), except that the nearest point of relief must be in the water hazard and the ball must be dropped in the water hazard or the player may proceed under Rule 26. The ball may be cleaned when lifted under this Local Rule. Exception: A player may not obtain relief under this Local Rule if (a) interference by anything other than such a tree makes the stroke clearly impracticable or (b) interference by such a tree would occur only through use of a clearly unreasonable stroke or an unnecessarily abnormal stance, swing or direction of play.
6. A device that measures distance only may be used for all play. A measuring device designed to gauge or measure other conditions (e.g., gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc.), is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.

ETIQUETTE

1. 90° Rule - When carts are permitted on fairways, please stay on paths until opposite your ball. After playing your shot please return to the cart path.
2. Please keep carts on path around tees and when within 30 yards of the green.
3. Please fill your divots with sand, repair all ball marks and rake bunkers. Please leave rakes in bunker after use.
4. Please stay within one shot of the group ahead.
5. Please observe posted Recreation Centers of Sun City Rules and Regulations.
