2022 Sundial Series Ticket Packages on Sale October 1

Lovers of live music are sure to be thrilled as the opportunity to get series ticket packages for the exciting line-up of shows coming to Sun City AZ for the 2022 Sundial Ticketed Concert Series is nearly here! The first day of series ticket package sales is Friday, October 1, 2021 starting at 8am at the Sundial Events & Entertainment Office.

The Recreation Centers of Sun City is super excited this season to offer two shows for each performance - a matinee concert at 3pm and an evening show at 7pm (doors will open at 2pm and 6pm respectively), which will allow for smaller, more intimate audiences and greater opportunities for physical distancing.

Season packages and individual show tickets will be available for each performance (individual performance tickets do not go on sale until Monday, November 15). Please note that season ticket packages cannot be a combination of matinee and evening shows; they must be for all afternoon or for all evening shows.

The cost for Season Ticket Packages with reserved seating for this line-up of twelve amazing shows will be \$216 per RCSC Cardholder (\$18/pp/show) or \$240 per RCSC Cardholder for Premium Seating (\$20/pp/show) which will be on sales through November 12, 2021 to RCSC Cardholders only (limit one series/card). Purchases may be made in person at the Sundial Events & Entertainment Office or by phone at 623-561-4680 (you must speak with a live Events Agent). Email requests for tickets can be sent to events@suncityaz.org and will be processed the same day of receipt. All ticket sales are final but tickets are transferrable if you should be unable to attend.

Bobby Wilson, Son of Jackie Wilson **Wednesday, January 12, 2022**

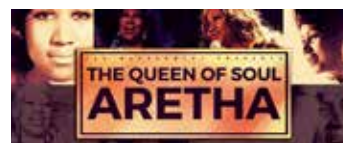

A Message from Board Secretary Dale Lehrer

Statement Regarding Director Dismissal

To Whom It May Concern:

Upon review with RCSC Legal Counsel, the decision has been made to share some of the circumstances leading to the removal of Karen McAdam from the RCSC Board. The authority to remove a Board Member by the Board of Directors comes from the RCSC Articles of Incorporation Article IX, Paragraph A: "By a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members of the Board of Directors after a member of the Board is absent from three (3) or more consecutive regular meeting of the Board **or who, in the opinion of such two-thirds (2/3) of the Board Members, is unwilling or incapable of performing his or her share of the duties and responsibilities of a Director.**" The following are among the circumstances leading to the decision to remove Ms. McAdam from the RCSC Board:

1. Shared details of a Board Executive Session in an open, public forum violating RCSC Bylaw Article V, Section 5 wording: **"All matters discussed in an Executive Session shall remain confidential indefinitely."**
2. Violated Board fiduciary responsibility through multiple conflict of interest violations, which defies RCSC Bylaws Article V, Section 6A, subsection 4: "The Board's fiduciary duty requires Board of Directors to act in the best interests for the benefit of the Corporation. **This duty requires Board of Directors to avoid conflicts of interest and acting of self-interest...**"
3. Threatened a member of the RCSC Staff with potential consequences for not taking action associated with Ms. McAdam's self-interests. This created a potential Legal liability for RCSC if allowed to continue.

The Board is not at liberty to disclose or discuss the content of or discussions at Board Executive Sessions. The foregoing items are, however, actions which occurred outside of Executive Session.

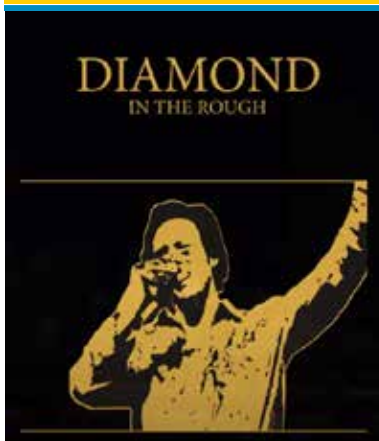

Thoughts from a Pro

3 Steps to Hitting The Golf Ball Better

Let's face it.... everyone is different. However, regardless of age, gender, strength, flexibility, height, or weight, hitting the ball better is about learning to make consistent contact. Here are three steps that can enhance anyone's swing without trying to remake the wheel!

Step #1 - Develop a good pre-shot routine. This means having a consistent way to approach the ball every shot every time. It includes alignment to the target, grip, stance, and posture. To me this is the most important factor since it is the foundation of the swing.

Step #2 - Relax. This is the biggest problem I see in most swings that I watch day in and day out. Tension is a killer of distance, direction and contact with the ball. (If you are hitting the ball short, right or on the top - I'm talking to you!) Many times, it's more than just relaxing your grip. Remember tension can start from the shoulders and work down the arms into the hands.

Step #3 - Make a smooth balanced swing. When the swing is smooth and in balance, it is much easier to make good contact with the ball consistently. Why? Physics. Try and hit a small little ball with a relatively small clubface while falling backwards, forwards or to the side and your chances decrease. Additionally, the smoother you are the more likely you are to use your body parts in the correct order (timing) which also increases consistency. As a drill see if you can hold onto your follow-thru position until the ball hits the ground. If so, the chances that you were smooth and balanced are pretty good!

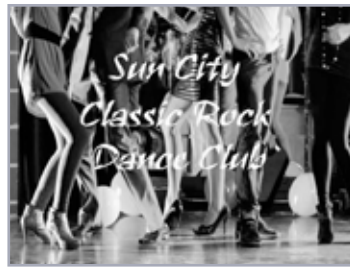
Sun City Women's Chorus

Jewelry, Stained Glass & More

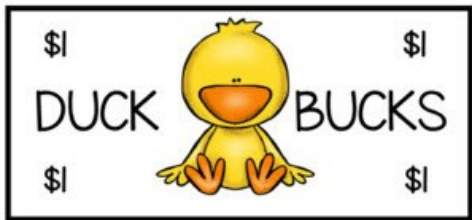

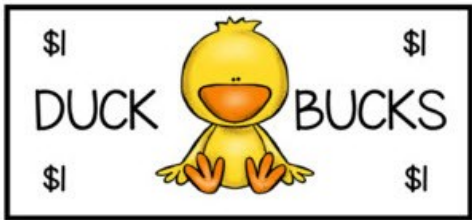

Water Conservation

It's Time to Adjust Your Irrigation for Fall

While we don't "fall back" for daylight savings time here in Arizona, autumn is the perfect time of year to adjust your irrigation controller for the season. As the weather changes and the temperatures drop, the water needs of your plants also change. Just as we increase the watering frequency in the summer when the temperatures ramp up, it's important that we can scale back watering for the fall and winter months. You can adjust your irrigation timer by following these simple steps:

Basic Controller Features

- **Stations** control the valves that release the water to the irrigation **Zones** in your yard or garden. Put plants with similar water needs on the same station or zone. This allows for more efficient watering since all emitters and/or sprinklers on a single valve will run for the same amount of time. Multiple stations or zones allow you to customize watering amounts for different types of plants by allowing for different run times for different valves.
- The **Start Time** is the time at which a specific valve will open to irrigate a station or zone.
- The **Run Time** or **Station Duration** is the time, in minutes, a specific valve will stay open and therefore water a zone.
- **Semi-Auto** lets you run through an entire program (A, B, or C) whenever you want a supplemental watering.
- **Off** or **Stop** will stop programs from running until you toggle back to 'Run'. Your programs will be saved. This is great during rainy periods.
- The **Manual** button allows you to run a single valve for the amount of time you select. This is helpful when you want to tune-up your irrigation system and check for leaks, misaligned sprinkler heads or clogged drip emitters.
- A **Program** is where you store all of your settings. It consists of a set of stations set to specific start times and run times. Here, multiple programs A, B, & C allow you to run different valves on different days with different run times. Make sure each program runs stations with similar plant water needs to maximize irrigation efficiency.

Programming Your Controller

1. For easy programming, first slide the "Set Program" (1) toggle to the middle, and then start in the upper left corner of your controller and move clockwise through the settings. Start with program A (2).
2. Set the dial to current time and use the +/- buttons to locate the current time of day. Turn the dial one click to the left and use the +/- buttons to locate the day of the week. You only have to do this once (3).
3. Turn the dial to the "valve run times" to select a station and use the +/- buttons to enter the amount of watering time for that valve, which sends water to a particular zone in your yard or garden (4).
4. Turn the dial to start times and use the +/- buttons to select time you'd like your irrigation to begin. You can have three different start times per day, but typically you only need one (5).
5. Now turn the dial to "schedule" the days you want your irrigation to run or the numbers of days to skip in between watering. Use the +/- buttons to enter this information (6).
6. Now repeat steps 3, 4 & 5 for each station/valve you are controlling, and program A is complete. Use programs B & C for other zones that require difference frequencies of watering, such as turf, Xeriscape, vegetable gardens, etc.
