Injury- (Major i.e. Loss of Consciousness, Blood and/or Faculties) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Wait for professional assistance ● Notify Club Officer/Monitor ● Complete incident report 	X	
Injury- (Minor with ALL Faculties available) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Wait for professional assistance ● Notify Club Officer/Monitor ● Complete incident report 		X
Threats- (Verbal/Physical) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Do not approach ● Keep distance and find locked shelter ● Notify Club Officer/Monitor ● Complete Member Conduct Report 	X

Vandalism- (No known Perpetrator) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Notify Club Officer/Monitor ● Complete incident report 		X
Vandalism in Progress- <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Do not approach ● Keep distance and find locked shelter ● Notify Club Officer/Monitor ● Complete incident report 	X	
Weapons Found on Person- <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Do not approach ● Keep distance and find locked shelter ● Notify Club Officer/Monitor ● Complete incident report 	X

What Happens When You Dial 9-1-1?

- A 9-1-1 call-taker will ask “what is your emergency?”
- Be prepared to tell them if you need the Sheriff, Fire Department, Ambulance/Paramedics.
- Stay on the line and follow instructions.
- Be prepared to answer questions about your location and the nature of your emergency.
- Listen carefully, speak clearly, and try to remain calm.
- Requests for assistance are dispatched on a priority basis, with the most serious calls dispatched first.
