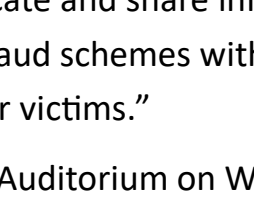

Join County Attorney Rachel Mitchell and Sheriff Paul Penzone at an important FREE event TOMORROW at [Sundial Center](#), to keep you and your friends and loved ones safe from fraud.

The Maricopa County Sheriff's Office and the Maricopa County Attorney's Office will be providing safety information to residents at the **Safety and Fraud Summit** on two topics - trending scams and residential security.

The event takes place on Wednesday, November 15th at the Sundial Recreation Center. The presentations begin at 9 am and will conclude around noon.

Approximately 20 vendors will be at the venue to share other resource information.

Maricopa County Attorney Rachel Mitchell and Maricopa County Sheriff's Office Chief Deputy Skinner will open the Summit. The purpose of the Summit is to educate and share information on the ever-advancing fraud schemes with the hope of preventing further victims."

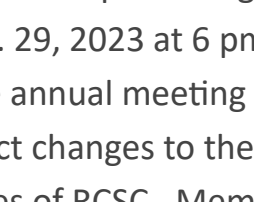
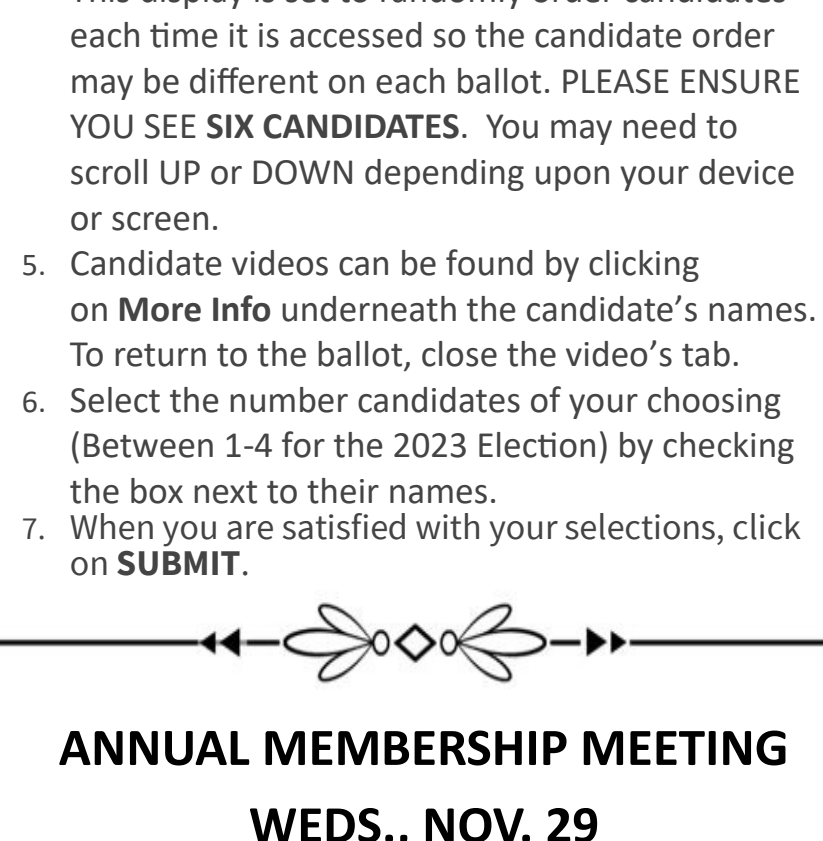


LAKE BOAT PARADE IS BACK!

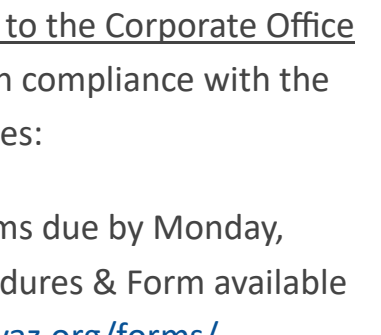

BOWL WITH THE DIRECTOR

Her arm held high as she practiced her swing positions, RCSC Member Kathy Meredith learned something new on at the [Lakeview Lanes](#) and the monthly Bowl with the Director event.

"Straighten your arm out as you swing," Mike Dirmyer, the Director of Bowling for RCSC, advised her as he demonstrated his tip. "Notice your follow through, watch your arm swing."

Kathy is one of dozens of RCSC Cardholders and Members who take advantage of the monthly event held at the bowling center adjacent to the Lakeview Center, the first Thursday of every month between 10:30 a.m. and noon.

It is an opportunity for those who may not have bowled in a while, to regain their confidence and remember the skills that they enjoyed in the past, explained Dirmyer, a Bronze Level Certified Coach. Many also join to get pro tips from Dirmyer and other area coaches who help out. The event is free to Cardholders and members and no reservations are required.

"Some people have not picked up a bowling ball in maybe 20 years," Dirmyer said. "We want to help reintroduce our Members and Cardholders to bowling, so they can regain the joy the sport has always brought all ages and generations."

In many cases, Sun City residents are asked to join a bowling league by a friend – but want to try out their game and practice before jumping right in, he said. "It's really amazing to see how thrilled people are to have an opportunity to regain their confidence and start enjoying one of our nation's favorite activities again," Dirmyer said. "We want our Lakeview and Bell lanes to be special places for our Members and Cardholders to create new memories well into the future."

The training even has high-tech opportunities in which Members and Cardholders can have their performance measured with detailed accuracy as to the direction of their throw, the speed of the ball, and more. **Join Mike on Thursday, December 7th!**

ELECTION: HOW TO VOTE ONLINE

1. Click on PORTAL LOGIN (top right side of page)
2. Enter your Member number and password. **NOTE: If you have not yet activated your new portal account, [click here for steps](#).**
3. On the top menu bar, hover your mouse over ELECTION and then click on VOTE. You may also view their bios by clicking on **Candidate Info**.
4. The next screen will show you the list of **NOTE:** This display is set to randomly order candidates each time it is accessed so the candidate order may be different on each ballot. PLEASE ENSURE YOU SEE SIX CANDIDATES. You may need to scroll UP or DOWN depending upon your device or screen.
5. Candidate videos can be found by clicking on **More Info** underneath the candidate's names. To return to the ballot, close the video's tab.
6. Select the number candidates of your choosing (Between 1-4 for the 2023 Election) by checking the box next to their names.
7. When you are satisfied with your selections, click on **SUBMIT**.
