The Maricopa County Sheriff's Office and the Maricopa County Attorney's Office will be providing safety information to residents at the Safety and Fraud Summit on two topics - trending scams and residential security.

The event takes place on Wednesday, November 15th at the Sundial Recreation Center. The presentations begin at 9 am and will conclude around noon. Approximately 20 vendors will be at the venue to share other resource information.

Maricopa County Attorney Rachel Mitchell and Maricopa County Sheriff's Office Chief Deputy Skinner will open the Summit. The purpose of the Summit is to educate and share information on the ever-advancing fraud schemes with the hope of preventing further victims."


