Review/Amend Prior Meeting Summary: Darrel Larson noted that the furnished prior meeting summary was not correct, changes were made without his knowledge. Changes with Mike Dirmyer's position plus two new bowling staff members. The Summary from the April 4, 2024 meeting stated that Don Myers title was Vice President of the Sun City Bowling Association (SCBA) which is incorrect, Don Myers title is Treasurer of the SCBA. The April 4, 2024 Summary was accepted as amended. (Co-Chair Richtmyre reviewed the original April summary submitted by Darrel and noted it listed Don Meyers as Vice President, not as Treasurer of Sun City Bowling Association. Mike Dirmyer, RCSC Non-Golf Sr. Leader:

Summer leagues are beginning to hit the floor, leagues that have yet to begin are still being promoted.

The first weekend of the Sun City Open has been completed. Bowling concludes this weekend for the event.

The Summer No Tap series at Bell Lanes on the last Sunday of the month continues on May 26th. We are still running two squads, one at 9:00am and one at 1:00pm. The 1:00pm squad is already full.

This summer we are continuing our preventative maintenance program on the pinsetters. This work will be completed throughout the summer. Bowlers may notice a pair of lanes out of service each day, we will try not to affect members ability to bowl.

Current bowling game pricing is \$2.85 per game for members and \$3.50 per game for guests. Mike Dirmyer is proposing raising members to \$2.90 per game, and guests to \$3.75 per game. League bowling pricing for the 2024-2025 season will remain the same as 2024 since contracts were signed at those rates.

Mike has hired a new supervisor Christine, and Reid Gibb, who has been with RCSC for a year, is being trained for increased responsibilities.

Bruce Lamb, USBC League Director: Bruce reported that having just returned from the National Board meeting, he learned that bowling is increasing, and new memberships have also increased. Bruce also noted that for the Bowling for Veterans approximately \$41,000 was raised in Metro Phoenix.
