A message from Director Thomas Foster

The Annual Budget Process

Building the annual budget for the RCSC takes a number of individuals and several months to complete. The goal of the budget process is to (1) estimate the RCSC's expenses for the upcoming year; (2) provide an acceptable level of amenities and services; and (3) identify a reasonable level of fees. Unfortunately, inflationary pressures continually put pressure on the RCSC's ability to provide the expected level of amenities and services.

The RCSC budget breaks down into four divisions. These divisions are (1) golf; (2) non-golf (includes bowling and clubs); (3) facilities; and (4) finance & support. The annual budget process begins with various assumptions for wages, benefits, repairs, maintenance, utilities, operating expenses, and RCSC employment levels for each of these divisions. The golf division and the bowling portion of the non-golf division, set their fees at a level intended to generate sufficient revenues to cover their operating expenses. The rest of the divisions have minimal revenue streams and their operating expenses must be covered by the annual assessment. If revenues and expenses are thought to be out of balance, then the budget will need to be adjusted. However, reduced expenditures generally will yield reduced amenities. Hence, there is a constant tradeoff between the level of fees, the amenities that the fee level will support, and the attractiveness of the Sun City community relative to neighboring 55+ communities.

There are numerous small capital expenditures, for instance a treadmill in a fitness center, a mower for lawn bowling, or equipment used by one of the RCSC's many clubs, that are financed from an account called the Capital Improvement Fee ("CIF") Fund. This account is funded by the Capital Improvement Fee which is a fee included in the closing costs when a home in Sun City changes hands. These capital expenditures are part of the annual budget.

The proposed 2025 annual budget will be reviewed by the Finance, Budget & Audit Committee in its September and October meetings. After this review the Finance, Budget & Audit Committee will recommend a budget to the RCSC Board. There will be a town hall meeting in October where the membership may ask questions regarding the proposed budget. The RCSC Board will review the budget recommended by the Finance, Budget & Audit Committee at its October and November meetings and will adopt the 2025 proposed budget, or some variation thereof, during these board meetings.

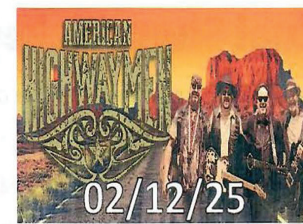
Open Ticket Sales

Library Lease Still Under Review

RCSC has been in ongoing discussions with the Maricopa County Library District (MCLD) regarding the library lease. The MCLD has submitted the latest lease document to their legal department for review. We will keep you informed as developments occur.

RCSC has partnered with triArc for the Mountain View / PAC Project and is currently exploring different locations to potentially relocate the Performing Arts Center (PAC) to better serve the community's needs. triArc is evaluating several potential sites for the new PAC location.

Thunderbird Property Update

This spring, RCSC engaged in discussions with the broker for the property at 111th Ave & Thunderbird. After multiple rounds of negotiation, we submitted our best and final offer to the seller. The seller declined our offer, and as a result, we have concluded the negotiations. Together, we can make these spaces vibrant, useful, and reflective of our community's spirit.

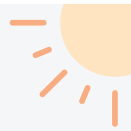

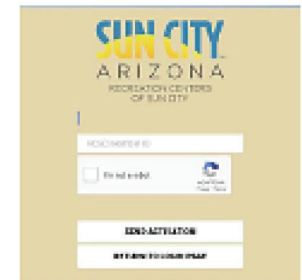
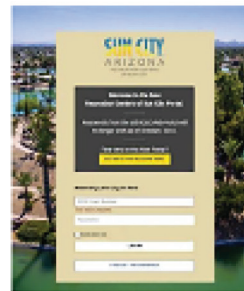
