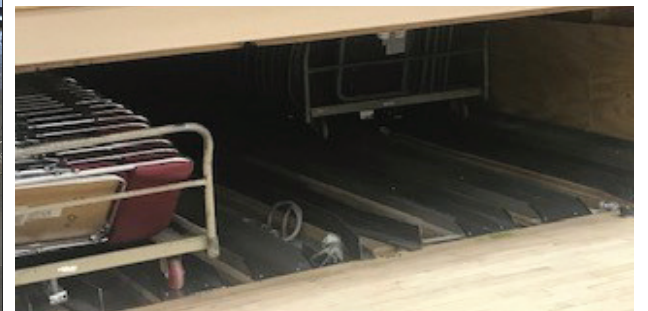


Exciting Updates at Sundial and Sun Bowl



Sundial Pool Upgrades

From June 24th to July 15th, the Sundial Pool was temporarily closed for maintenance and modernization. During this period, several significant projects were completed to enhance the pool area and equipment. The interior of the pools, previously inaccessible for cleaning, was power washed, and new safety drain covers were installed. New tile was added to the ramps of both the big pool and the warm water pool. The pool pumps were replaced, and variable frequency drives were added to improve energy efficiency. The pool filtering material was upgraded, and the pool deck was repaired, thoroughly cleaned, and fitted with new joint covers. Numerous vendors and internal departments coordinated efforts to ensure all projects were completed within the shutdown timeframe.

Sundial Stage Improvement

Significant improvements were made to the Sundial stage during the first two weeks of July to eliminate a safety hazard for employees. Previously, the chairs and tables for events were stored underneath the stage on worn wooden tracks, causing difficulties and safety issues. The project included installing new 18-gauge steel tracks for

smoother cart movement, adding center rails and wheels to the carts where needed, and performing structural upgrades to stabilize the stage. Hazards protruding through the decking were also removed. Completed in mid-July 2024, this project has created a safer and more efficient environment for employees.

Sun Bowl Parking Lot Repaving

The Sun Bowl parking lot underwent a major repaving project, timed perfectly to follow the last show at the Sun Bowl and the completion of the new softball buildings. The project, completed in just over two weeks, included several improvements aimed at benefiting our members. ADA parking was relocated closer to the dome for easier access, and the grading was adjusted to ensure better water flow away from the bowl during heavy rains. Additional parking spaces were dedicated to Sun City Fire for emergency assistance. Finished in June 2024, this repaving project, which came in under budget, will last for 50 years with proper maintenance.

These upgrades are designed to enhance the experience and safety for all our members. Enjoy the improved facilities!

Modernizing RCSC: Progress and Future

In May of 2021, the first RCSC Technology Committee was called to order to begin a journey long in the making thanks in no small part to now President Fimmel. The focus was to provide a better understanding of RCSC's strengths and challenges when it came to the utilization of technology within our Centers as well as what the path forward would look like to modernize and meet the needs of our membership as our use of technology evolved.

Three years later we have come a long way. The Technology Committee worked with our Information Technology (IT) Manager to understand where we were currently at and where we needed to go. After an audit of our IT Infrastructure and Operations architecture, the Technology Committee supported IT Manager Randy Bird's request to completely update RCSC's IT Infrastructure and Operations (I&O) to meet modern standards. The Committee also made recommendations to the RCSC Board to budget the initial costs of the upgrades and to add a line item to the budget to support ongoing technology needs within RCSC. In addition, the Committee made presentations to the RCSC Board related to our technology security risks and workable solutions going forward.

With the arrival of Covid, the demand for IT I&O hardware and software needs across the country increased exponentially. This demand significantly slowed RCSC progress forward due to a new phenomenon within the IT community - substantial backorders.

Some of the new equipment like updated laptops and printers were delivered quickly and obsolete equipment and software was replaced. But others like servers and storage arrays took a year or more to be delivered, which delayed installation and implementation. What normally would have taken less than a year became a 3-year project that we are now coming to the end of.

While waiting for the finalization of the I&O upgrades last year, the RCSC Technology Committee began the process of vetting companies for the long-planned website redesign. We created and delivered a Request for Information (RFI) to 40+ companies and by utilizing an objective measurement process, we narrowed the field for potential companies down to 12 candidates which were then ranked and passed forward to the Board for Request for Proposal (RFP) requests. As the Committee completed their work on the website redesign, they moved on to items on our agenda such as researching the technology needed for access control and the next phase of upgrades for software and I&O integration and interfaces. Next up for the Committee will review and make recommendations for our future business solutions and how we ensure that we are planful in our approach and implementation.

As we move through 2024, we are looking for new members for the Technology Committee. If you have the skills or a background in IT and would like to join the IT committee, we would love to hear from you. If you would like to be part of shaping the future.

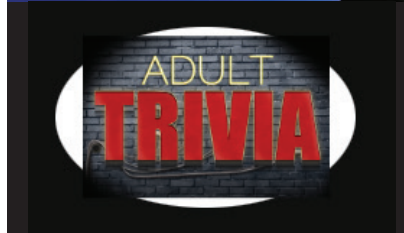

Celebrating the Legacy and Support of Sun City Libraries

Since the 1960s, our Sun City Libraries have served the community with dedication. In 1974, we opened a space at the Fairway Center, followed by the launch of a second facility at the Bell Center in 1976. As a private library operating without tax funding, we faced financial challenges. Most of our staffing came from generous volunteers, and we organized regular fundraisers to cover the costs of books and operating expenses. One of our most popular events has been the annual bridge tournament, and library subscriptions also contributed to our revenue, as library cards were not free.

By 2009, it became clear that our libraries needed to modernize to offer essential services, such as a digital catalog and public computers. That year, we joined the Maricopa County Library District, transforming the Sun City Library, Inc. into the Friends of the Sun City Libraries, Inc. Our mission is to enhance the community by supporting our libraries.

We signed a five-year lease that was renewed in 2014 and 2019, and as we approach 2024, we are currently negotiating again amid discussions about the future of the Fairway Branch.

The Friends run a used bookstore that sells books, audiobooks, music CDs, DVDs, magazines, and puzzles—most of which are donated by local residents. The store operates 36 hours each week, run entirely by volunteers. All proceeds go directly to supporting our two library branches, with around \$40,000 allocated each year for additional resources.

Furthermore, the Friends fund special projects that enhance our services. For example, we collaborated with the RCSC to install drive-up book returns at the Sun City Branch at Bell, contributing about \$66,000 to the project. Recently, in 2023-24, we funded the installation of electrical outlets for technology and lighting improvements in the meeting room, which cost around \$18,710.

The Friends play a crucial role in supporting our two branch libraries through advocacy, financial help, and volunteer efforts. Remember, GREAT LIBRARIES NEED GREAT FRIENDS!
