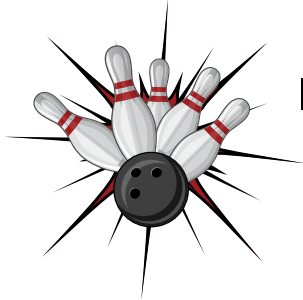
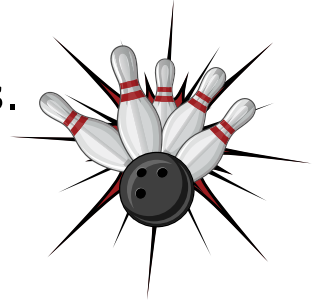

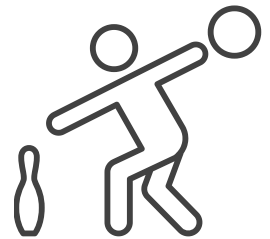

Tournament Rules

1) Eligibility

- Tournament is open to **all current league officers of leagues at Bell Lanes and Lakeview Lanes** for the 2024-2025 bowling season. Secretaries, Treasurers, Sergeants at Arms, Presidents, Vice Presidents and Team Captains are eligible to participate. Each officer can bring one friend, significant other or spouse to participate in the tournament.

2) Format

- This will be a 3-Game Singles Handicap Event. Handicap is based upon 90% of the difference between the entrant's average and 220. Minus handicaps will not be used.
- The scoring method will be 9-Pin No-Tap.

3) Averages

- Bowlers will use their highest average from the 2023-2024 season.
- If no '23-'24 average, use '22-'23 average or 2024 summer league average.
- If you only bowl in No-Tap leagues, you are welcome to enter. A conversion chart for your No-Tap average will be used for re-rating purposes.
- If the above criteria are not available, the bowler will use the highest average as of April 1 provided that the average is representative of 21 games or more.
- If none of the above criteria are met, the bowler will be assigned an average of 220 for this tournament.
- All averages are subject to re-rating by the Bowling League and Tournament Manager.

4) Warm-Up

- There will be 10 minutes of warm-up immediately preceding the start of the tournament.
- Tournament participants may not practice within 2 hours of the squad time on the tournament lanes.

5) Payouts

- Cash prizes will be awarded on a handicap basis.
- There will be a 'Mystery Score' payout for the first two games. This is included in the entry fee.
- 1 in 3 entries will be paid.
- Tournament will have 2 Divisions: Men's Division and Women's Division
- The current USBC Rulebook shall govern any rule not covered above.

6) 'Bowl-with' Requests

- An effort will be made to grant requests to bowl with a certain group, but it is not guaranteed.

7) Check-In

- All bowlers must check in 30 minutes prior to the start of the tournament.
- Bowlers must check scoresheets to confirm averages.
