Scotch Doubles Tournament Rules

1) Eligibility

- a) Each bowler must be 50 years of age or older.
- b) A team may only submit one entry. The same two bowlers cannot bowl as team in both squads. However, a bowler may enter into both squads if they bowl with a different partner.
- c) Each entry must be a team of 2 bowlers. Any gender combination can be used to form a team, so long as the team's combined average does not exceed 400 (see Averages section).

2) Format

- a) This will be a 4-game Scotch Doubles Handicap Event.
 - This is an alternating shot format.
 - Choose a teammate to bowl first. From there, the team will alternate shots until the conclusion of the fourth and final game. A bowler will never bowl consecutive shots.
 - This also applies to the end-of-game -> start-of-game shots. Whichever teammate did not bowl the final shot in the preceding game bowls the first shot of the subsequent game.
- b) The tournament will consist of 2 Squads (9 AM and Noon).
- c) The scoring method will be 9-Pin No-Tap.

3) Averages

- a) Each bowler will use their highest average from the 2023-2024 season.
- b) If no 23-24 average, use 22-23 average or 2024 summer league average.
- c) A team's combined average must not exceed 400.
- d) If you only bowl in No-Tap leagues, you are welcome to enter. We have a conversion chart for your average. Note The converted averages (not the No-Tap averages) will be used in regard to determining whether a team's combined average is under the 400 combined average cap.
- e) If a bowler cannot provide a verifiable average from the options above, they will be assigned an average of 220.
- f) All averages are subject to re-rate by the Bowling League and Tournament Manager.
- 4) Handicap is based upon 90% of the difference between 400 and the team's combined average, divided by 2.

5) Payouts

- a) The tournament shall have two divisions based on team average.
- b) The division specifications shall be determined once all entries are received.
- c) 1 out of 3 entries shall be paid out for each division.

6) Squad Time selection

- a) Entry into squads will be given on a first come-first serve basis. Each squad is limited to 48 team entries.
- 7) An effort will be made to grant all requests to bowl with a certain group, but it is not guaranteed.
