## Ensuring RCSC Facilities Stay in Top Shape

The RCSC Properties Committee plays a key role in the ongoing maintenance of RCSC facilities, which include eight golf courses, eight recreation centers, the Sun Bowl, and the Softball complex. This dedicated group of volunteers inspects every property three times a year. During these inspections, committee members team up with Center Leaders or Greenskeepers to walk through recreation centers and tour golf courses using carts, ensuring that every area receives thorough attention.

Each inspection covers a variety of spaces, such as club rooms, restrooms, pool areas, maintenance facilities, and mechanical rooms. Golf course inspections also include assessments of paths, cart bridges, snack bars, pond embankments, remote restrooms, and drinking fountains. The goal is to identify potential safety hazards or maintenance issues early, before they become larger problems. Typical issues might include faulty plumbing fixtures, cracked flooring, worn tiles, eroded embankments, or exterior building damage.

Following the inspections, reports are promptly submitted to RCSC staff, and if needed, work orders are generated to track repairs. Many issues, such as minor cleaning tasks or small repairs, are often resolved by staff before the inspection report is even processed. This system ensures that the Properties Committee helps prevent maintenance problems from escalating. Their work is crucial for keeping facilities functional and safe for the RCSC community. Even the Mountainview Recreation Center, which is scheduled for extensive remodeling and/or demolition, undergoes regular inspections to ensure it remains operational until the new facility is built.

Members of the Properties Committee come from various backgrounds, bringing diverse experiences and insights. However, no specific skills in construction, maintenance, or safety are required—just a desire to contribute to the upkeep of RCSC properties. The committee provides an additional layer of oversight by serving as a second set of eyes to identify potential issues that might go unnoticed.

The next Properties Committee meeting will be held on November 26th at 9 AM in Social Hall #2 at Lakeview Recreation Center. The top three candidates with the most votes will serve 3-year terms and the next two candidates with the highest votes will each serve a one-year term. Candidates must receive a minimum of 100 votes in order to win a seat on the Board. Should there not be an adequate number of eligible candidates elected, the Board will appoint another Member(s) to complete the term(s) which remain unfilled.

RCSC Cardholders will have the opportunity to **meet the candidates** and hear their stance on the issues at **two Candidate Forums** on Monday, November 18 from 12:30 to 2:30pm and Wednesday, November 20 from 6pm to 8pm. Both Forums will be held in the Sundial Auditorium located at 14801 N. 103rd Ave. Candidates will be available to meet and greet attendees starting 30 minutes after each session and light refreshments will be offered. There will also be the opportunity to view video recordings of these sessions on the RCSC YouTube channel for those unable to attend in person.

Other opportunities to meet and speak with the candidates include upcoming Exchanges and Board Meetings (if candidates attend) October 31 at 9am, November 11, 28 at 9am and December 9 at 9am. All Exchanges and Board Meetings are held in the Sundial Auditorium

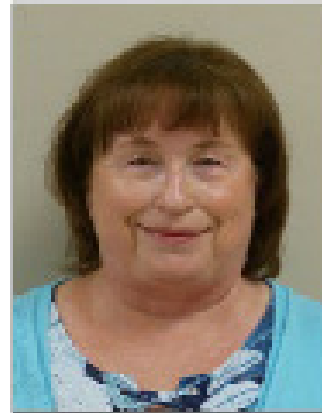

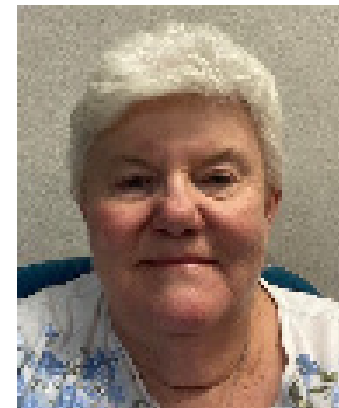



## Finding Confidence, Sisterhood, and Joy with the Sun City Poms

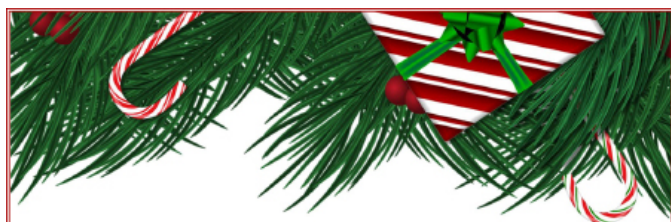

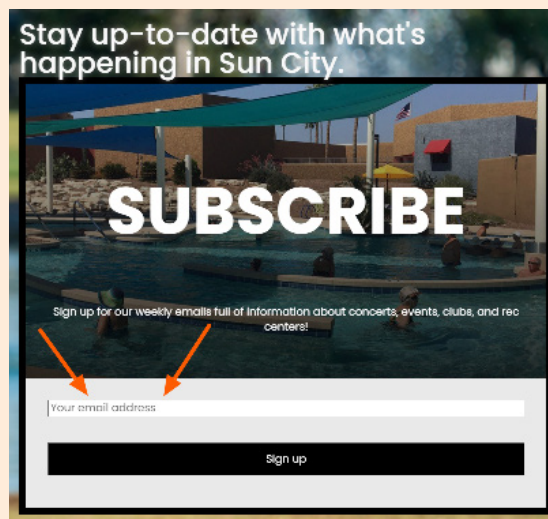

## Sun City softball league debuts new modern facility

The Sun City Softball League marked the grand opening of its new clubhouse, batting cages, and storage building at the Sun Bowl Softball Field on Oct. 19, attracting hundreds for the event and the start of the new season.

The ceremony honored past presidents, founding members, the RCSC board, and others involved in the facility upgrades. Outgoing president Ron Coppas said, "We are a strong club because of volunteers willing to work."

The \$1.3 million project, which began in November, replaced the clubhouse and added new storage and batting cages. Founders Doug Wright and Tait Douglas, who helped launch the club in 1989, were recognized for their efforts.

"This was just a small building with two restrooms and no storage," said current president Steve Oberg. The new clubhouse now offers improved restrooms, a meeting room, concession area, climate-controlled storage, and a "crow's nest" for announcers.

Oberg called the batting cage the highlight: "Not too many places have these, and it really makes us stand out."

The RCSC board approved the project in 2020, but the pandemic delayed it. The league, with over 250 members, plays year-round, with fall games Monday through Saturday and a 65-and-over league.

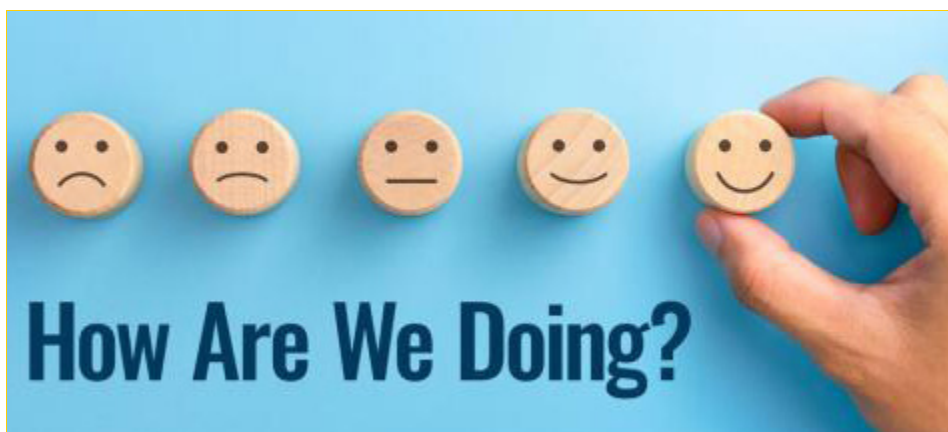
