TOURNAMENT RULES

1) Eligibility

- a) While professional bowlers are participating in this event, only amateurs will qualify for prize fund winnings.
- b) All amateurs must **either** be a current league bowler (fall or summer) at Bell Lanes or Lakeview Lanes and/or be 50 years of age or older to participate.
- c) Both Men and Women are eligible to enter.

2) Format

- a) This will be a 3-game Handicap Event.
 - **Multiple Doubles Pro-Am Format.**
 - Amateur bowlers will be assigned lanes, and bowl on the same lanes for all three games of the tournament.
 - Pro bowlers will be randomly assigned a pair of lanes to start on and will rotate to a new pair each game.
 - The pro bowler's score will be combined with each individual amateur bowler's score for the game in which they are bowling together on the same pair.
 - The results will be calculated based on a Doubles format, with the scores consisting of the amateur's three games (including their handicap), and the combined single-game scratch scores of the three different pro bowlers they bowled with.
- b) The scoring method for all bowlers (including professionals) will be 9-Pin No-Tap.

3) Averages

- a) Each amateur bowler will use their highest average from the 2024-2025 season.
- b) If no 24-25 average, use 23-24 average or 2024 summer league average or current league average.
- c) If an entrant bowls exclusively in No-Tap leagues, they are welcome to enter. RCSC has a conversion chart for the no-tap average.
- d) All league averages require a minimum of 21 games.
- e) If a bowler cannot provide a verifiable average from the options above, they will be assigned an average of 220.
- f) All averages are subject to re-rate by the Bowling League and Tournament Manager.

4) Handicap

- a) Handicap is based upon 90% of the difference between 230 and the entrant's average.
- b) **Professional bowlers will not use handicap, regardless of average.** All professionals will bowl scratch.

5) Payouts

- a) The tournament shall have two divisions based on average.
- b) The division specifications shall be determined once all entries are received.
- c) 1 out of 4 entries shall be paid out for each division.
- d) Only amateur bowlers are eligible to win and collect prize money. Professional bowlers may not collect any money from the prize fund.

6) 'Bowl-With' Requests

- a) An effort will be made to grant all requests to bowl with a certain group, but it is not guaranteed.
- b) Bowlers may request to bowl with other amateurs, but they may *not* request to bowl with specific professional bowlers. The professionals will be assigned lanes at random on the day of the tournament, after amateur lane assignments have been finalized.
