The Fall Bowling Season has come to an end for several leagues, with a handful finishing in May. The Summer Leagues will begin as early as this coming Monday, May 5th. Each center will host seven summer leagues.

Lakeview Lanes hosted the 16th Annual League Officers Tournament in April. The tournament is hosted as a thank you to all our league officers and team captains for the contributions and time spent on making our centers such a great place to bowl.

Last weekend, the long-running Sun City Open kicked off a great weekend. The tournament is held at each center, with Bell Lanes hosting the Teams event, while Lakeview Lanes hosts Singles/Doubles. The turnout has been terrific, and the tournament concludes this Saturday and Sunday.

Looking ahead further, Bell Lanes will host its end-of-month No-Tap Tournament on May 25th. This will be the first singles event of the tournament series, and it has already received the maximum number of sign-ups for both squads with over 130 bowlers slotted to participate.

 - Division 2 (<739) winners were Sharon Carter, Richard Prince, Joe Carter and Chris Ogaard
- No Tap Doubles event scheduled for May 10th currently 80 entries
- Rock N Bowl Party July 19th DJ and Bowling
 - o Currently taking reservations currently 78 registered
 - o Fee \$25 pp − includes 3 games of no-tap, colored pin bowling, mystery score and free soft drinks/water
- SCBA Senior Scratch Trio League ended second season with a full team roster of 24 with a prize fund of over \$26,000. A few teams have dropped as well as a few individuals, however they have been replaced and expect a full roster for the 2025/2026 season
- SCBA 2025/2026 tournament/event schedule met with Reid and a prepared draft schedule is currently being presented to the board for approval

- Price increases for other services within bowling (i.e., alcohol) and golf addressed by the Chair and GM:
 - Both bowling and golf have to cover their own operating expenses and must follow deed restrictions. Alcohol prices are lower at the bowling lanes vs the golf snack shops. Bowling prices were compared to the marketplace with guest prices rising faster than the member prices. Review continues.
