Mountain View Progress

- Completed:
 - triARC Visioning Phase completed
 - triARC Visioning presentation to members completed
 - triARC Engineering Survey completed
 - triARC visioning communication posted to the website, hardcopy presentations are in all centers, and the digital copies of all documentation is posted on social media (YouTube/Facebook)
 - RCSC BOD/Management provided list of stakeholders
 - Final scope of Mountain View Programming phase outlined between RCSC Board and triARC



Mountain View Progress

- Completed:
 - Stakeholder questions for Stakeholder interviews finalized
 - Final list of stakeholders sent to triARC
 - Clubs currently using Mountain View
 - Clubs with potential to use Mountain View
 - Facilities/RCSC Stakeholders
 - Member names provided to the Board requesting inclusion
 - Club Stakeholder interviews scheduled
 - Programming plan finalized



In Progress for the RCSC BOD

- Usage data to triARC
 - Researching collection of historical data for longitudinal analysis
 - 2024 Club and general member usage numbers
 - 2025 January to June
- July and August YouTube video progress update
 - No later than July 14th and August 11th
- triARC Board presentation and data analysis in preparation for Townhalls
- Schedule Townhalls for triARC Programming presentation
 - Early to mid September
 - Reviewing option to live stream for members not currently in Sun City
 - If not feasible may need to revisit date for Townhall
 - Date to be scheduled by end of June



In Progress for triARC

- Mountain View Programming
 - Ongoing Stakeholder Interviews
 - All clubs contacted and scheduled
 - All RCSC stakeholders contacted and scheduled
 - General membership stakeholder meetings to follow once Club Stakeholder meetings are completed
- Deliverable:
 - Analysis of Stakeholder interviews and update of existing data from previous phases of Mountain View project
 - Base concept drawings for Mountain View at the completion of the Stakeholder interviews
- Timeline: approximately 7 weeks remaining



Member Engagement

- Continue to participate in the Stakeholder Interviews
- Non-club Stakeholder interviews will be conducted once Club interviews are completed.
- Continue to communicate with the Board regarding thoughts, questions, concerns, and ideas for Mountain View.
 - Request that Members reach out to the Board of Directors rather than directly to triARC



What comes next

- Complete Stakeholder focus groups with key Non-Club Stakeholders
 - To be scheduled in approximately 2-4 weeks
- triARC Programming presentation to Membership
 - Stakeholder input and influence on Programming outcomes
 - Base concept drawings for Mountain View
 - These are not detailed design or architectural drawings
 - Continued alignment with budget
 - Timeline: ~ September, 2025
- RCSC Board sends communications to the Membership as final decisions regarding the Mountain View buildings are made as the Programming phase wraps up
- Mountain View renovation design phase begins upon completion of the Programming phase
