Approval of prior meeting Summary: The Summary from the November 3, 2016 meeting was approved.

Randy Johnson, RCSC Director of Bowling: Randy informed the committee of the upcoming tournaments which include; Cactus & Pine, ACBA Tournament and King of the Hill. A new league, with 48 bowlers from Brunswick Zone Glendale, has begun bowling on Wednesday mornings at Lakeview Lanes. This leagues season runs for 36 weeks which is great news. The 2016 New Year's Bowler-Rama party to be held at Lakeview Lanes has 149 guest signed up and is sold out. Randy also informed the Committee of decisions that were made regarding guest bowlers in our league rules and conduct.

Don Meyer, USBC League Director: Don informed the Committee of the upcoming USBC Tournaments and that Arizona is number one in donations for BVL. We raised over \$23,000 for our veterans.

Lovie Tiedje, Sun City Hall of Fame President: Nothing to report.

Roger Beebe, Sun City Bowling Association President: Roger informed the Committee that current membership is 671 with more members renewing.

Old Business: None

New Business: Questions were raised concerning "Break the Bank" rules for employees. Randy informed the Committee that current rules state that an employee who bowls can only receive 50% of the proceeds if they win the daily event sum in league play. Discussion was had and a motion was presented to remove this rule and change it to make all bowlers eligible for a 100% payout should they win. A vote was taken and the motion passed unanimously.

Bowling fees will be increased effective January 1, 2017 due to Proposition 206 being passed. All areas of Sun City will be affected by this new law.
