APPROVAL OF PRIOR MEETING SUMMARY: The Summary from the December 2, 2021 meeting was approved as presented.

Mike Dirmyer, RCSC Director of Bowling: Mike reported on upcoming Events at Lakeview Lanes January 8 Bowling Over Cancer Fundraiser with a full 120 people signed up for this event. Sunday January 9 is the Skip Lynn Memorial Fundraiser. January 15 is the next No-Tap Tournament scheduled and already has 91 bowlers signed up for the tournament. There are currently no events scheduled in the month of January for Bell Lanes so that bowling center will be fully available for open play.

A new program has been developed and will begin in February. The first Thursday of every month from 10:30am until 12:00pm will be "Bowl with the Director" at Lakeview Lanes. This is an open time to come out and meet with the new Director of Bowling, Mike Dirmyer. Mike is a USBC Bronze Level certified coach with over forty 300 games, fifteen 800 series, and multiple state and city tournament titles in several states. There is no cost and no reservation needed and all levels of bowlers are welcome. For first time bowlers, a learn to bowl lesson can be done. Intermediate bowlers can get some practice and coaching fitting their game. Advanced bowlers can discuss lane play, oil patterns, and ball layouts. This is an open opportunity to come visit and ask any questions that you might have regarding the bowling centers, the bowling industry, or any other general questions. SPECTO will be available.

Bruce Lamb USBC League Director: Bruce reported that this year's Bowling for Veteran's Link (BVL) contributions given by area bowler totaled over \$6,000. The bowling community is very supportive and all funds are used in Arizona.

Roger Beebe, Sun City Bowling Association President: Roger reported that membership totals exceeded 800 to date. Hall of Fame inductees and the annual meeting scheduled for February has been postponed due to a Covid surge. New time and date will be posted when available.

New Business: Sue Wilson will remain Chair of the committee for 2022 and Darla Akins will be Co-Chair. The Committee thanked them for their support and work on the committee.
