Upcoming events at the centers are CBE Senior Singles Scratch Tournament on January 8<sup>th</sup> at Bell Lanes, The Bowling Over Cancer fundraiser on January 14<sup>th</sup> at Lakeview Lanes, Our house run No Tap Tournament on January 21<sup>st</sup> at Lakeview Lanes, The Sun City Bowling Association Hall of Fame No Tap Doubles Tournament on January 28<sup>th</sup> at Lakeview Lanes and The house run Scotch Doubles Tournament on January 29<sup>th</sup> at Bell Lanes.

Bell Lanes is starting back up the Wednesday 4:00pm No Tap bowling league January 11<sup>th</sup>. Due to the overwhelming popularity, we decided to try a 12:00pm No Tap league beginning January 18<sup>th</sup>. There are 10 teams of 4 already signed up for it.

We are taking sign-ups that include the bowlers RCSC number. The members are given priority if we fill up an event or a league. It is very important that the members fill out that line on the sign-up form.

New pricing went into effect on January 1<sup>st</sup>. Members will pay \$2.70 per game, and guests will pay \$3.15 per game. League pricing does not change mid-season. Any new leagues beginning after January 1<sup>st</sup> will be charged the new pricing. Note that the pricing increase reflects a 5-cent increase in member rates and a 25-cent increase in guest rates.

In response to committee feedback, the front of the building at Lakeview Lanes where the paint had been worn off has been re-painted. We have also begun an opening league announcement promoting upcoming events.

**Bruce Lamb, USBC League Director:** Stated that Sun City bowlers have contributed over \$9,000 in funds to AZ Veterans and the current metro funds are at \$30,000. The metro Phoenix USBC are currently reorganizing the office staff. Area league officers will be keeping us informed. USBC tournaments and dates are listed at the bowling centers.

**Lynda Bettini, Sun City Bowling Association President:** Lynda reported that the 2022 New Year's Eve Bowler Rama at Lakeview Lanes was sold out and a great success. Invitations have been sent out for the February scheduled Hall of Fame event.
