APPROVAL OF PRIOR MEETING SUMMARY: The Summary from the February 2, 2023 meeting was approved as presented.

Mike Dirmyer, RCSC Director of Bowling:

Bowling continues to be as busy as ever in recent years. In February there were 31,720 games bowled, the most since 2012. The most open bowling games were bowled at both centers since we started keeping track in 2004.

Revenues in February were up 21% over the prior year and in 2023 are currently up 25% over the prior year. Increases are attributed to the open bowling popularity, new league programs developed, and additional tournaments being offered.

In March we are hosting the SCBA Doubles Tournament, the 14th Annual League Officer Appreciation Tournament, the 28th Annual Ladies No-Tap Tournament, and the monthly Bell Scotch Doubles Tournament.

We have begun promotion on the 33rd annual Sun City Open Senior Bowling Tournament scheduled for the last weekend in April and first weekend in May.

The Summer league booklet is off to the printers, we should begin promoting summer leagues next week.

Bruce Lamb, USBC League Director: Bruce reported that the Bowlers to Veterans Link (BVL) contributions by the bowling community have already reached \$10,000 and growing.
