Mike Dirmyer, RCSC Non-Golf Sr. Leader:

Fall leagues are beginning to hit the floor, leagues that have yet to begin are still being promoted. We expect to be full every evening with leagues and have updated some programs that allowed some leagues to grow a little over the previous year

This summer we continued our preventative maintenance program on the pinsetters. This work was completed throughout the summer. We also did the yearly maintenance on the oiling machines.

The side aisle by lane 1 at Lakeview Lanes was torn out and cement put in. This looks much better, will require less maintenance on the area, and is safer for the mechanical staff.

Current bowling game pricing is \$2.85 per game for members and \$3.50 per game for guests. Bowling has proposed price increases to \$2.90 and \$3.75. This pricing will become effective January 1, 2025. Please remember league pricing is locked into the end of the league season.

Staffing reminder, with my new role I moved our current League and Tournament Manager into the Manager office at Lakeview Lanes taking on an expanded role in the bowling department. Vicki retired but is still doing the league secretary work at Lakeview Lanes. Our new Lakeview Lanes supervisor is working nights and weekends, her name is Christine Walkinshaw. Bell Lanes is still the same with Nancy Bollman running everything there.

Bruce Lamb, USBC League Director: Bruce reported that there will be no increase in dues for the next 2-3 years. New awards are available, contact the front desk for more information. Bruce also noted that for the Bowling for Veterans approximately \$13,600 was raised for 2023-2024.

Lynda Bettini, President of the Sun City Bowling Association and Sun City Hall

of Fame: Jacqueline Smith reported in Lynda's absence that the 2023/2024 total membership is 1,034 compared to last year which was 922. A total of 155 awards were provided to our members in 2023/2024 which exceeds the total handed out in 2022/2023 which was 78. The SCBA Board Meeting is scheduled for October 19, 2024.
