Approval of Prior Meeting Summary: The September 9, 2020 Meeting Summary was approved as presented.

Report by Myrna DeBruyne, Chartered Club Supervisor: Distributed to the Committee for review:

The Chartered Clubs Office has completed RCSC Chartered Clubs 2021 Facility Scheduling. President Packages will be ready for pick up beginning November 2, 2020. An email has been sent to all Presidents informing them of the date.

To date, 33 RCSC Chartered Clubs are/have reopened:

Arts & Crafts = 19
Education = 1
Hobby = 3
Music = 1
Sports = 7 (4 being Lawn Bowling Clubs)
Various = 2

One Club has been shut down for 60 days by RCSC due to inability to enforce sanitation/safety protocols within their Club. The Club will have to reapply to reopen at the end of 30 days.

One Club has been given a written violation warning. Should the Club continue being non-compliant, it will be shut down for an indefinite period.

There are currently 2 Clubs who have submitted requests to reopen. They are under review.

The Chartered Clubs Office is working on instructional videos for "How to complete RCSC Chartered Club Forms". This project should be completed by the end of December. Staff title changes need to be corrected in Board Policy #12 and on corresponding Board Policy #12 Forms.

Chair Wilson mentioned that clubs may need to change their Bylaws to allow for electronic or email voting due to the Pandemic (Act of God). Board Policy #12 was also changed to further make accommodation for the Pandemic and club operations. Club Officers will most likely stay in their current positions for another year or until the members of the clubs can meet and have an election. Presidents packets well be available on November 2nd in the Clubs Office and Myrna is working on forms training videos at this time. Officer Training classes may not be scheduled for this year due to COVID-19.
