Chair Steve Collins called the meeting to order at 10:00am in the Lakeview Center Boardroom

Approval of Prior Meeting Summary: The June 14, 2023 Meeting Summary was approved as presented.

Report Angella Willette, Chartered Club Supervisor: Distributed to the Committee for review.

- Application for a new Charter Club, Fun City Card Club, has been requested to be on the agenda at the next RCSC Board meeting.
- The club's reservation system, RecTrac, is being upgraded. Club services will not be impacted during this time. During the live migration there may be a day or two when the system will be down. The club's office will time and date stamp requests and enter them when the migration is complete.
- Club Rosters are due October 1, 2023. A reminder email has been sent out to Club Presidents.
- 10 clubs need to turn in attendance for August. Reminder emails have been sent out to the Club Presidents.
- 2024 club schedules have been completed. Once Joelyn is completed loading events into the directory, we will begin distributing the President Packet. This year the packets will be emailed to Club Presidents.
- Working on the New Officers Training Program. Training will be held in January.
- Joelyn will be holding publicity workshops with clubs to discuss SunViews Club Directory, Annual Club Articles, Flyers, and RCSC Club Webpages. The dates of the workshops are October 19, 2023 at Bell and Sundial, October 20, 2023 at Lakeview and Fairway and October 23, 2023 at Grand. A formal invitation will be sent to Club Presidents.
- Ceramics at Bell Center has reopened following the remodel of their club room.

Chair Report: Chair Collins stated that there are issues concerning chronic memberships in “like-kind” clubs. The problems arise where a member is written up for some type of bad behavior, suspended for a certain period of time in one club, then joins another similar club, and continues the bad behavior. There has been no way of tracking these offenders in the past. There needs to be some type of system created between the clubs, COC and the RCSC to fix this problem. A robust and lengthy conversation took place concerning previous and potential situations concerning profanity, touching and threat incidents between individuals and the club’s Board Members. It was decided that the procedures, guidelines, suspensions and punishments need to be updated. COC's, over the summer, will meet to create a flow chart for procedures in handling serial offenders for presentation at the September meeting.
