- RCSC Board President Jerry DeLano will write two articles for the SunViews, one in June and the other in October or November.

- Quorum of 1,250 discussed.
- Chair Van Ness entertained Candidate Forum questions from the Election Committee Members.
- Chair Van Ness to set schedule for Committee Members to visit RCSC Committees and Clubs.
- Candidates to be at the November Arts & Crafts Festival and have the member sign in sheet for absentee ballot requests.
