Election Committee September 22, 2021

Approval of Prior Meeting Summary: The Meeting Summary for June 23, 2021, meeting was approved as presented.

Discussion:

Chair Hoffer informed the committee of the upcoming election dates for the Candidate Forums and asked Corporate Executive Coordinator to email a copy of the schedule to the committee members. Discussion was had on the location of the forums this year and that they will both be held at the Sundial auditorium. One will be held in the afternoon and one in the evening, both will have a social 30 minutes prior to the forum, and both should last around 2 hours. Live streaming will be done this year for the first time. A question was asked if technology was why both are being held at the Sundial Auditorium instead of one at Fairway and one at Marinette. It was agreed that the feeling was that we would have a higher voter turnout this year.
