## RCSC Elections

### Your Vote is Your Voice - Be Counted

RCSC Board of Director elections are nearly here and now is the time to learn more about the candidates who will appear on this year's ballot. There are three candidate vying for the three upcoming vacancies and those elected will serve three-year terms. Expiring terms are currently held by President Jerry DeLano and Directors Darla Akins and Stella VanNess. Biographies of each of the candidates can be found on page 3.

Members are encouraged to attend one of two upcoming Candidate Forums on Monday, November 4 and Thursday, November 7 where there will be opportunities to hear candidates respond to both mediator and audience questions. There will be social time with light refreshments one-half hour prior to each session. (More details regarding these Forums can be found on page 2). For those members unable to attend, video recordings of both session will be posted on RCSC's YouTube channel. Reminder notices also will be sent via RCSC News Email Alerts.

Online voting via the RCSC Web Portal will be available starting at 8am on Monday, November 11, 2019 and continuing through Election Day at 4pm on Tuesday, December 10, 2019. Members may also request Absence Ballots by contacting the Corporate Office at Lakeview Center at 623-561-4600. All absentee ballots must be received prior to Election Day. The only in-person voting location will be at Lakeview Social Hall #2 on Election Day from 8am to 4pm. You must present your RCSC Member card in order to participate in these elections.

Candidates in attendance will also be introduced at upcoming Board Meetings on Monday, November 11 and Thursday, November 21, 2019 at 9am in the Sundial Auditorium. There will be one final opportunity to discuss the issues with candidates who will be manning a table in at the Sun City Arts & Crafts Festival in the Sundial Auditorium Lobby on Friday and Saturday, November 29 and 30.

Candidate literature continues to be available at RCSC recreation centers, golf pro shops, bowling centers and outside Cardholder

Services, Clubs and Events & Entertainment offices on the lower level at Lakeview.

While there may be some concerns that having the same number of candidates running as there are vacancies available might indicate that voting is not necessary. Please be aware that your vote is your voice and each candidate is required to receive a minimum of 100 votes in order to win the election. In the event a candidate does not receive 100 votes, the Board of Directors has the authority to appoint a member to fill the position.

## 2020 Sundial Concerts

### First Day Sales at Sundial Only

First day sales of Series Ticket Sales for the 2020 Sundial Concerts will go on sale at 8:30am on Friday, November 1, 2019 at Sundial Center ONLY. There will be NO online ticket sales this year.

On November 1, RCSC Cardholders may obtain numbers beginning at 5:30am to secure your place in line and the Sundial Auditorium will be open and available for your comfort should you elect to not return home or attend to other matters prior to the start of sales.

For those purchasing series tickets, there will be two options this year: "Premium" Reserved Seating for \$220 per Cardholder (\$20 per concert) OR Regular Reserved Seating for \$198 per Cardholder (\$18 per concert). Member or Privilege Cards must be presented for each series ticket package being purchased.

Cardholders may purchase tickets by phone at 623-561-4680. You must speak with a live ticket agent; no voice mail messages requesting to purchase tickets will be returned nor will email requests be accepted.

Season ticket packets for the Sundial 2020 Winter/Spring Concert Series will be on sale throughout the month of November only.

## RCSC Cardholders:

# Please keep the following in mind when using RCSC Facilities

While you're out and about enjoying all that RCSC has to offer, please be aware of the following items which require Cardholder attention when using any of the recreational facilities:

- All RCSC Cardholders are required to check in with their Member or Privilege Cards (key fobs accepted for entry to fitness, pools and spas only; not accepted concerts or free events).
- Neither Sun City AZ residents nor spouses of RCSC Cardholders are eligible to be guests. With proper documentation and if eligible, privilege cards may be purchased at the Cardholder Services Office at Lakeview Center in order to use the facilities.
- Host punch cards are purchased by and belong to the Cardholder, not the guest. Host punch cards can be purchased at RCSC Facility Attendant Stations (exact cash or check only), Cardholder Services at Lakeview and RCSC Bowling Centers.
- Guests should be prepared to show government-issued photo ID when checking in to use RCSC facilities.
- Proof of age for 4 and 5 year olds (birth certificate or passport) is required for access to swimming pools. Photo copies or electronic images are acceptable.
- Free concerts and events are paid for by RCSC Cardholders and are intended for RCSC Cardholders and their escorted guests only.
- Always be prepared to show your RCSC Member or Privilege card (with photo) when attending free concerts and

events. Key fobs are not accepted for entry.

- Immediately exit pools, spas if lightning is observed or thunder is heard.
- Household pets are NOT allowed at any RCSC facilities, including but not limited to buildings, golf courses, grounds, parking lots, except for dogs at the RCSC dog park, Best Friends Dog Club and/or dogs trained as service animals. Emotional support animals are not an exception.

Please refer to the RCSC Cardholder Guide and Board Policies for more information regarding these matters. Your continued cooperation is much appreciated!

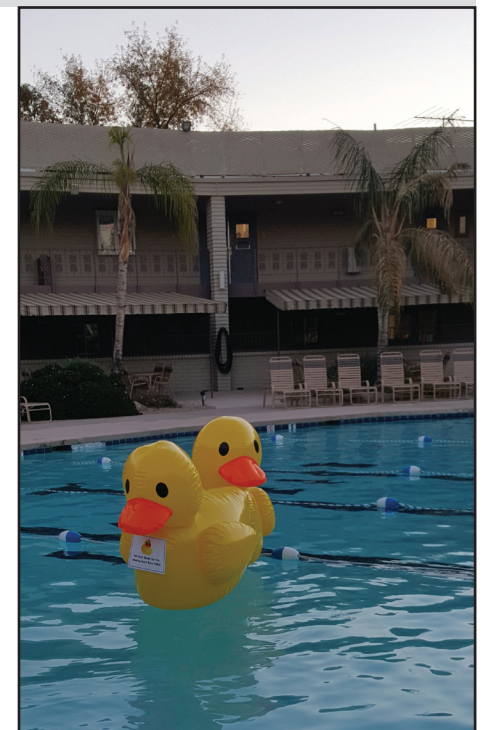

## Golf & Grounds Report

### Pro Shops

We had 80 participants in our Patriot Day golf event on August 30. Patriot Golf Day was organized with the help of PGA of America to raise funds for the Folds of Honor Foundation. Through entry fees, the 50/50 raffle and pro shop collections we raised a total of \$1,140. The money raised is used to fund scholarships for spouses and children of military service men and women killed or disabled while serving our country.

Free golf clinics begin Saturday November 9 at Lakes West/Lakes East and will be held on Saturdays through November 30. The clinics begin at 9:30am and are taught by our local PGA and LPGA teaching professionals. The clinics are geared for beginners, but are also beneficial for those looking to brush up on the fundamentals. Over the course of four weeks, instruction will be given on chipping, putting, irons and woods. Clubs will be provided for those that do not have their own. There is no need to preregister, though we do recommend arriving at least 15 minutes early.

On December 12 we will be hosting a fundraising tournament to raise money for our Sun City Foundation which assists those who have outlived their retirement. The format will be Beat the Pros, Director of Golf Brian Duthu and Pro Shop Manager Chris Linam, and will be made up of two person teams. Teams that beat the Best Ball score of the Pros will equally share the prize pool. The entry fee will be \$40 and the event will be held at the South Golf Course. In addition to bragging rights for beating the pros, there will also be a chance at a Pebble Beach Vacation.

### Snack Shops

Snack Shop closing times moved to 3:00pm beginning October 1. Hours of operation can be extended based on demand. Although Snack Shop revenues have recovered some, year to date total revenues still trail budget. We appreciate your continued support.

### Golf Courses

Long range forecasts are favorable for a September 30 start, as a result overseeding will begin as originally scheduled. Overseeding will begin on North, Lakes West, Willowbrook and Riverview. These courses will reopen October 19, with cart path restrictions in place until November 8. The remaining courses will close October 21 and reopen November 9 with cart path restrictions in place until November 22.

The practice area on the South Course will open September 30, to coincide with course closures as a result of overseed. As a reminder, the practice putting and chipping green surfaces will not be overseeded this year to protect them long term. As a result the green speed will be significantly higher on the practice greens than on the golf course. The difference in pace will increase as we move deeper into winter.

The yellow tees on Lakes West are now open for play. Ratings for the yellow tees as well as updated course ratings for the other tees are available in the pro shop. Lakes East was re-rated on September 4, those ratings will also be made available once they are received. Scorecards for both courses will be updated when current inventory is exhausted.

### Grounds/Lawn Bowling

Oakmont and Mountain View Lawn Bowl greens have received final leveling. Mowing heights have been lowered to their final cutting heights on both greens. We expect both greens to be open for play October 1. The greens at Lakeview and Bell have also undergone minor leveling adjustments. Sun City will once again be a host site for US Open from November 3-9.

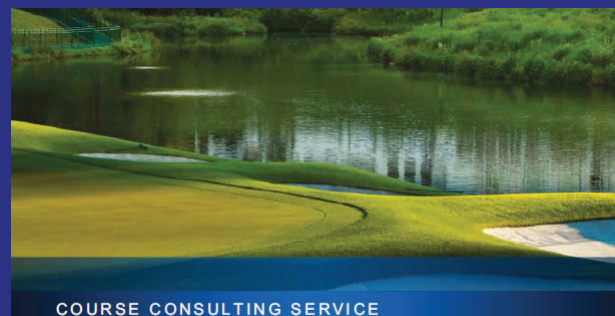

*Tips from a Pro***To lower your score...fine tune your short game!**

Short game shots make up nearly 70 percent of all shots taken in a round of golf. What does this mean for you? Well, for starters if you're looking to improve your score start by examining your short game and determining weak areas. Once you focus in on your problem areas here are some suggestions for practice.

**Putting:** Keep track of total putts during a round. For most players, averaging 2 putts per hole will be the goal. Practice with one ball on the putting green giving yourself short, medium, long, uphill, downhill and sidehill putts, finishing out each putt just like you're playing a round. If you play all 9 holes on the putting green, your goal score would be 18. Play against a partner and it's even more fun!

**Chipping:** Practice chipping with both a lofted club (like a PW) and a less lofted club (like a 7). The wedge will jump and run about the same amount, and the 7 will run 3 times further than it will jump. Visualize a hula-hoop around the hole and see how many times out of 5 you can get the ball onto the green and within that distance. Or, combine chipping and putting together with a goal score of three for newer golfers (one chip and two putts) or a goal of two (one chip and one putt) for more experienced players.

**Pitching:** Get to know the distance your ball goes on a full, 3/4, 1/2, and 1/4 swing with the PW before adding other clubs such as a SW, Gap Wedge or L wedge. Once you have your distances down with the PW you can decide about adding in some of the other wedges. Practice from varying distance away from the pitching green and see how many times out of 5 you can hit the green. For low handicappers see how many times out of 5 you can get up and down from varying distances.

Remember, working on the short game can not only be fun but it is usually the fastest way to lower your score!

# Your Vote Still Matters!

Well here we are once again. Election time in Sun City AZ. While many picked up candidate packets in earnest months ago, the sad truth is that only three members completed the process and only those three names will appear on the ballot.

While this may be disappointing and reminiscent of RCSC elections years back, the past several years have benefitted from having numerous candidates vying for vacancies. Though voter turn-out has continued to be lackluster over this same period, we were offered alternatives and varying viewpoints based upon each candidates' life experiences, professional background and goals.

However, just because there are a minimal number of candidates running does not mean that your participation in these election should be over just yet. According to RCSC Bylaws, candidates who receive less than 100 votes are not eligible to fill any of the existing vacancies. And if you feel that any of the candidates are not worthy of your vote or up to the task of being a Board Director, remember that you MAY vote for up to three candidates; you do not HAVE to vote for anyone you do not feel is qualified.

And the only true way to accomplish assessing the candidates and their credentials is by meeting them and hearing what they have to say on the issues. You'll have many opportunities between now and Election Day (Tuesday, December 10, 2019) to find out what matters to them, how they view their role on the Board and ultimately, the future of Sun City AZ.

All candidates are invited to attend upcoming Board meetings to be introduced to those in the audience. We will also be hosting two Candidate Forums (one on Monday, November 4 at 2pm at Fairway; the other on Thursday, November 6 at 6pm at Marinette). Light refreshments will be served beginning 30-minutes prior to start time so you'll have a chance to speak with the candidates one-on-one beforehand). Both of these Forums will be video recorded and posted on the RCSC YouTube channel for your review if you're not able to attend.

And you'll have one last chance to perhaps get better acquainted with the candidates at the annual Sun City AZ Arts & Crafts Festival at Sundial on Friday and Saturday, November 29-30, 2019.

Whether you're signed up for the RCSC Web Portal so you can vote online (starting on November 11), intend to request an absentee ballot or would rather make your way to the sole polling location at Lakeview Center on Tuesday, December 10 – just remember to vote.

How our great community proceeds into the future is up to you – and in the hands of those who we elect to serve on the RCSC Board of Directors.

## Management Report

### Financial Report

The Recreation Centers of Sun City, Inc. (RCSC) has ended August 2019 within its operating and capital budget year to date. All divisions with the exception of Golf have met or exceeded their net operating budget projections year to date with overall income at budget and overall operating expenses 3% favorable to budget. Golf fell below budget operationally due to the timing of the purchase of seed which was budgeted for a September purchase. Overall operating excess is 25% favorable to budget. In the month of August overall RCSC has exceeded revenue by 4%. Operating expenses were higher than budget primarily due to the early purchase of seed by Golf. The month of August was led by the Bowling division with net excess favorability of 24% driven by increased revenue. Golf revenue continues to improve with August actuals exceeding budget by 6%.

### Cardholder Services

Payments on past due assessments in August were 10.4% of past due balances. Overall accounts receivable decreased in August by 4.3% and is up 1.0% from the beginning of the year. Overall accounts receivable past due balances have decreased 3.0% since the beginning of the year. July assessments went 30 days past due at 6.9% rate and June assessments went 60 days past due at a 3.2% rate.

Payments from our third-party collections firm totaled \$7,779 in August. Year to date payments through our third-party collections firm total \$64,663. Payments made in August by Cardholders through the online RCSC Web Portal totaled \$118,184 from 256 property owners. Year to date web portal payments total \$1,093,646 from 2,371 property owners.

In August property transfer balances decreased by 7.0%. Outstanding balances related to property transfers represent 51% of all receivables and 52% of past due balances. As of August there are no pending balances for lender owned properties. At the end of August trustee sale notices on Sun City properties ended at 35 and properties owned by lending institutions increased to 7.

## Project Updates

### Bell Center

#### Silvercraft Club Room

All club items have been moved back into the club room from temporary storage. Countertop installation and rehang of shelves to be completed by 9/20. Most significantly the completion of cabinet doors is pending by RCSC Skilled Trades staff. These are approximately 70% completed with the completion of these items scheduled for the week of 9/23/2019. Final

electrical will be completed upon placement of tables. Work included flooring, ceiling grid, overhead lights, cabinetry, paint and environmental remediation. Contractor: Multiple (Cost \$81,955)

### Library Book Drop

Closure of the access road and asphalt demo is expected to begin by 9/23/2019. The access road closure will continue through the completion of the book drop island which is estimated to be 10/11/2019. This project includes the placement of library book drops on an island on the north access road behind the library, installation of an access gate in the block wall and lighting upgrades along the access road. The costs of this project are to be reimbursed by the Friends of the Library. Contractor: Regional Paving, Accel Electric, Kingsley Equipment (Cost \$67,403)

### Grand Avenue

- Review of the construction contract is completed and pending execution by both parties.
- Final permit application submitted to ADOT. Working with ADOT on an RCSC insurance requirement that falls short of ADOT requirements. Awaiting an approval from ADOT to accept the current level of insurance from RCSC.
- Awaiting response from the Vintage Vehicle Club on the space layout. Changes to support use by the club have been provided to the architect for inclusion in the design plans.

### Lakeview Center

#### Upper Restroom Remodel

All bids have been received and currently being reviewed for recommended contractor selection to the Bid Commission. Contractor: TBD (Budget \$110,000)

### Marinette Center

#### Pool Deck Replacement

No change on this project. The bid packet for this project was submitted to the Bid Commission and approved. This project will include the preparation of the delaminating areas of the current deck and the installation of a rubber decking material throughout the pool, spa and shower areas. Based upon historical usage of this facility this work has been pushed to November and will be completed from 11/11/2019-11/27/2019 with the pool area reopening for the Thanksgiving holiday weekend. With night time temperatures going into the low 50's this is the latest in the year that this work can be scheduled as lower temperatures affect the curing of the surface. This schedule has been reviewed with the Aqua Fitness club and the club is adjusting their scheduling to accommodate the work schedule. Contractor: Rubaroc USA Inc. (Cost \$125,328)

The replacement filters will provide more granular filtering and allow for backwashing of filters rather than manual cartridge cleaning. The replacement of the filters will be done during the closure period for the pool deck replacement. Contractor: Exceptional Water Systems, Osiris Pools (Cost \$31,261)

### Spa Filter Replacement

No change on this project. The bid packet for this project was submitted to the Bid Commission and approved. This project will include the replacement of the existing cartridge filters for the spa with deep bed sand filters with glass media. The replacement filters will provide more granular filtering and allow for backwashing of filters rather than manual cartridge cleaning. The replacement of the filters will be done during the closure period for the pool deck replacement. Contractor: Exceptional Water Systems, Osiris Pools (Cost \$20,600)

### Pickleball Pavilion Lighting

This project is pending the receipt of the fixtures. Upon receipt the installation will be scheduled. We have committed to the club that the lighting project will be completed before the fall tournament from 10/29/2019-10/31/2019. Contractor: Accel Electric (Cost \$63,992)

### **Sundial Center**

#### Club Restroom Remodel

All bids have been received and currently being reviewed for recommended contractor selection to the Bid Commission. Contractor: TBD (Budget \$100,000)

#### East Parking Lot Lighting Improvements

No change on this project with receipt of fixtures pending. Additional lighting is being added to the solar canopies on the east side of the center to provide better night time illumination adjacent to the building. Similar fixtures have been added to other centers and provided the desired lighting improvements. Contractor: Accel Electric (Cost \$7,667)

### **South Pro Shop**

The costs to complete the pending items: parking lot asphalt, patio counter, interior pendant lighting and exterior signage has been approved by the Bid Commission. Most work will be scheduled during the closure for overseeding with the building signage having a longer 8-10 week lead time. Contractors: Regional Pavement, Bootz & Duke Signs, RCSC Skilled Trades (Cost \$52,915)

### Water Conservation

## Water Wise Tips for the Yard & Patio

Finally! It's that time of year when we can enjoy the beautiful weather. While you're out and about, don't neglect to survey your yard and patio areas and see if there's not some water wasting situations that might need your attention. Here are just a few items to consider:

- Check your irrigation system frequently and make the necessary adjustments so only your plants are getting watered and not the house, sidewalk or street.
- Water plants only when necessary. More plants die from over-watering than from under-watering.
- Signs of overwatering include leaves turning lighter shades of green or yellow, young shoots wilting. Sometimes you may also notice algae or fungi growing.
- Adjust your watering schedule each month to match seasonal weather conditions and landscape requirements.
- For hanging baskets, planters and pots, try putting ice cubes on top of the soil to give your plants a cool drink of water without overflow.
- Proper pruning can help your plants use water more efficiently.
- Water your plants deeply but less frequently to encourage deep root growth and drought tolerance.
- Plant species native to the region and plant in the spring and fall, when the watering requirements are lower. Now is a great time to evaluate what's growing or what should be going!
- Spreading a layer of organic mulch around plants helps them retain moisture, saving water, time and money. Mulch also helps to minimize weed growth.

Now get outside and see what ways you can save water - both today and for future generations.

Sundial Craft Club members quickly got to work and created over 200 hats and scarves by the middle of September and ready for delivery before winter arrives.

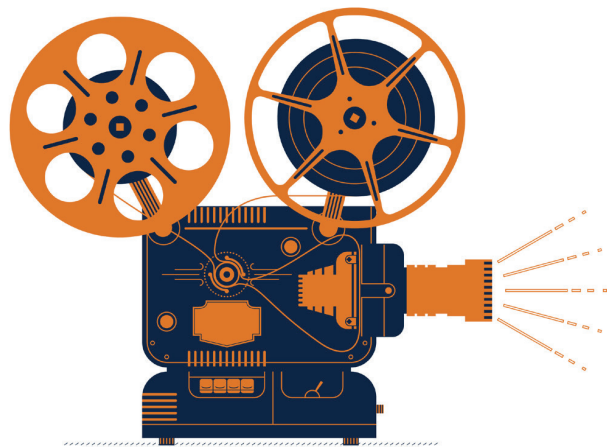

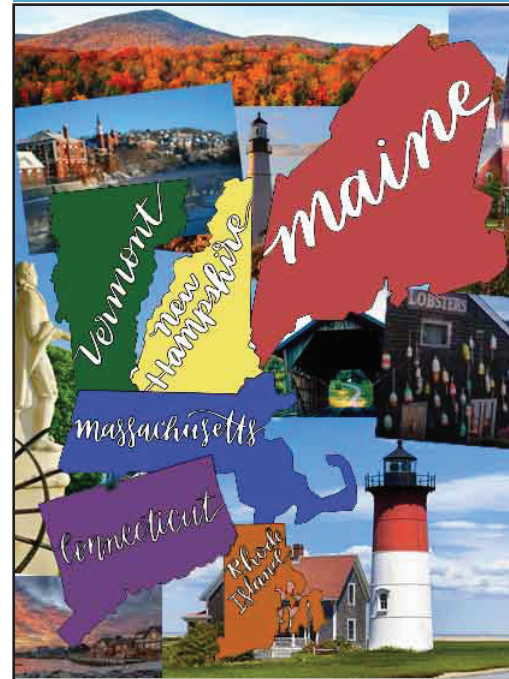
## Table Tennis Club

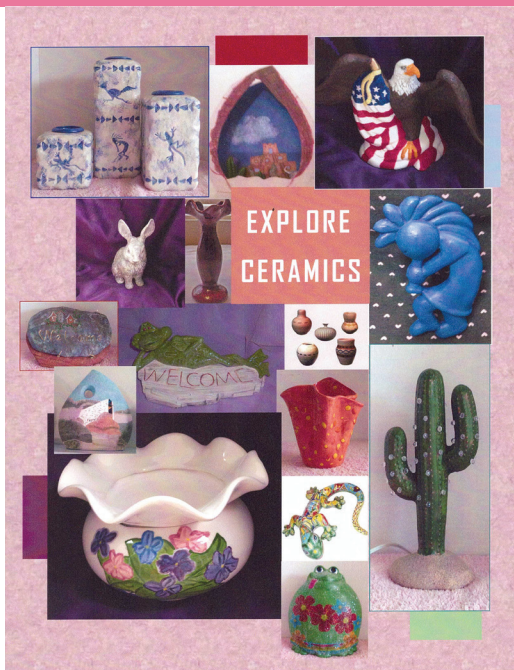

Tips from Get Fit for Life -

## 50+ Pounds to Lose

Part 1 of a 3-Part Series

"If you and your doctor have determined it's best for you to lose 50+ pounds, you might feel overwhelmed," states Jane Fortier, fitness professional. "The road to such a goal will be bumpy, but the destination will be worth the trip. To navigate the road successfully, consider the following tips."

- **Be patient.**  
You didn't gain that extra 50+ pounds overnight, so don't expect to lose it quickly. One to two pounds per week is considered safe, sustainable weight loss. You are likely to see more weight loss in the first couple of weeks, with things getting harder as you get fitter. Don't become frustrated - persistence pays off. Remember, it's not a race.
- **Surround yourself with a strong support system.**  
If you've always admired a friend's dedication to weekly workouts, a fitness instructor's commitment to helping people, a relative's uplifting social media posts, turn to these people for daily positive feedback - keeping in mind that their goals and fitness levels are different than yours. Spend time with people who support your weight loss efforts, not ones who bring you down or try to pull you off course.
- **Know exactly what you are eating.**  
A bite of your spouse's dessert, a sip of a friend's milkshake, a food sample at the grocery store - these all add up to extra calories, in the course of a day. Track the foods you eat each day. Log foods, so that you are eating three healthy meals a day, with three healthy snacks. Logging foods is tedious, but if losing 50+ pounds is your ultimate goal, this is a must. Cutting down on calorie intake and committing to the right kinds of calories is vital in any weight-loss plan. Portion control helps with caloric reduction. Avoid feeling "starved" and never feel "stuffed." Adopt an eating program you can stick with for a lifetime - not one that's trendy.
- **Step off the scale.**  
A scale is not always the best indicator of results. The scale doesn't take body composition into consideration - how much of the total weight is "lean body weight" and how much is "fat body weight". Girth measurements, progress pictures, and how clothes fit are better indicators of fat loss. Weight loss is never perfectly linear - the scale will go up and down day-to-day, so don't let a daily weigh-in knock you off course. Track inches lost.
- **Mix up your workouts.**  
Exercise is essential for 50+ weight loss. But, if you do the same workout day after day, your body adapts to the activity and becomes more efficient at performing it - this makes exercise less challenging and decreases results. Burnout and injury are more likely to occur, if you do the same workout every day. Recruit the help of a personal trainer to get the exercise mix that brings the best results, considering age, abilities and issues. Don't underestimate the magic of daily movement. In addition to gym workouts, you can burn plenty of calories with daily low-level activities: doing laundry; walking the dog; hauling groceries into the house; doing yard work. Never sit longer than 30 minutes without getting up and moving. Little bursts of movement affect mental clarity, energy level and total calories burned.

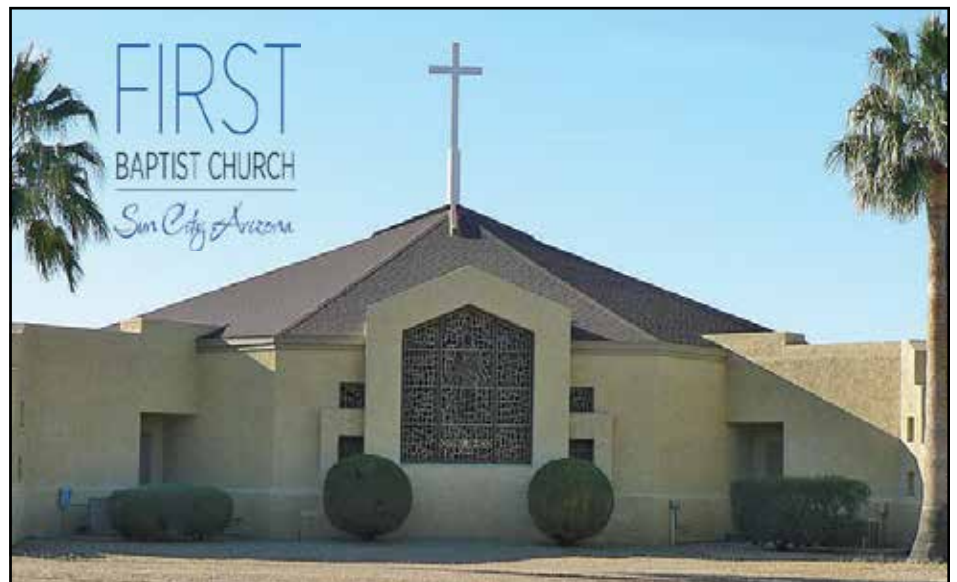

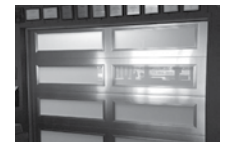

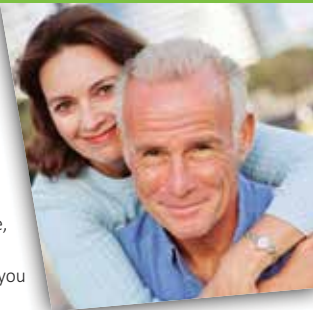

Records show that as the population of Sun City grew, so did use of our medical equipment. Savings for Sun City residents have been calculated periodically; in 2015, it was estimated that residents saved over two million dollars in cost of equipment for that year alone.

Sunshine Service, Inc has received local, state and national recognition. Awards received include the George Washington Honor Medal for services to the sick and handicapped from the Freedoms Foundation of Valley Forge in Pennsylvania.
