Looking Forward, Reaching Back

This past year has proved quite challenging. It began by including members in helping develop the annual budget. Members participated in meetings about the corporation's finances, asked questions, and made suggestions. We were shocked to learn the corporation had \$20 million in deferred maintenance. We created a Capital Improvement Fund (CIF) to address this issue. It brought to light the need to create a reserve study. We also created a 5-year plan team to address the corporation's major (PIF) projects. We understand the importance of showing members where the increases we passed will be going.

This past summer the Strategic Alternatives Committee (SAC) was brought together to address the Mountain View project. Through their efforts, strategic alternatives were developed, and in conjunction with the Long-Range Planning Committee, we shared these plans with the membership at four town hall meetings. These are the plans the Board of Directors used to create the "elements" document that will be used to contract with an architect-engineer to design the project. This design process will explain how this entire project will roll out, and more importantly will provide the actual cost of construction.

We also saw how far behind our technology needs were. We have achieved a level of technology where our systems have been converted to SD/WAN; however, we need to continue our technological efforts to meet continuing demands for service. Over the coming months, management will be developing a Request for Proposal (RFP) for a complete website redesign.

One of the most important challenges we faced was hiring a new General Manager. There was an extensive list of community needs that had to be addressed; we faced both short-term and long-term issues that also needed to be addressed. The new General Manager, Matthew D'Luzansky, is member focused, supports transparency, and quickly addressed several long-standing weaknesses in our day-to-day operations. His commitment and focus are to take both the corporation and the community to the next level.

Together we have come to understand the importance of accountability. We also understand the important role management plays in the day-to-day operation of our amenities, while the board of directors is engaged in supporting, planning and providing long-term direction. Taking a moment to look back, we can embrace the importance of the membership being part of the solution. We also know that when we are open and willing to listen, we will be a better, stronger, and more result oriented, and successful organization.

Tips From A Pro

Expedient Play Makes Golf More Fun

The game of golf is more enjoyable for everyone if it moves along efficiently. This doesn't mean you have to feel rushed or hurried while hitting your shot. It simply means no matter what the situation is, you prepare yourself for your next shot before it's your turn. If everyone does this on every shot the game moves along quicker for everyone regardless of ability or handicap!

On the tee box this means when someone else is hitting you are checking yardage and deciding which club you will use and have that club out with a ball and tee in hand ready to take your turn. "Ready golf" means that whoever is ready should go ahead. (Honors is giving the person with the best score on the last hole the opportunity to hit first).

On the fairway once you have hit your shot, fill the divot if you took one, and then get in the cart, perhaps even waiting to replace the headcover, wipe the club, or return it to the bag until the next stop, especially if you are not the driver of the cart. Near the green it means letting the person whose ball is already on the green drive the cart around to park it while the other person (who needs to chip on) walks to their ball taking a couple clubs to chip with and their putter (so an additional trip to the cart can be avoided).

On the green it means contemplating the break, line, or speed of the putt while others are putting and knowing who you follow so that when that person is tapping in or marking you are getting ready to take your turn.

And last exit the green expeditiously when everyone has finished putting and remember not to mark your scorecard until you get to the next tee box.

Remember little things add up to lots of time over the course of a round! It's not about rushing your shot... it's about preparing ahead of time so you're ready to go when it's your turn. That makes all the difference in the world to those you're playing with! (And those behind you as well).

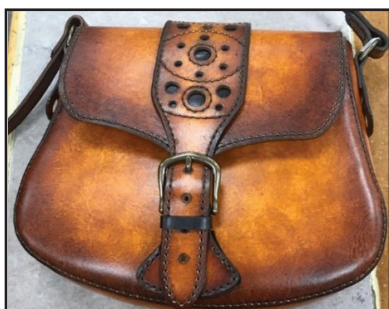

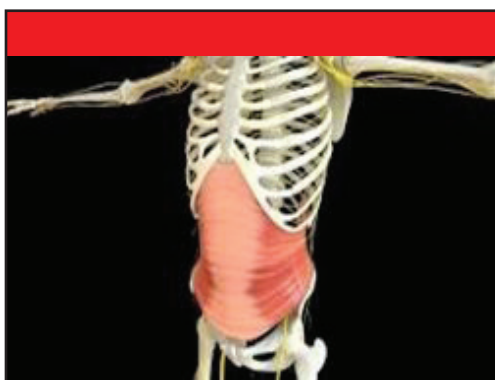
tember through May and summer classes are usually available June through August.

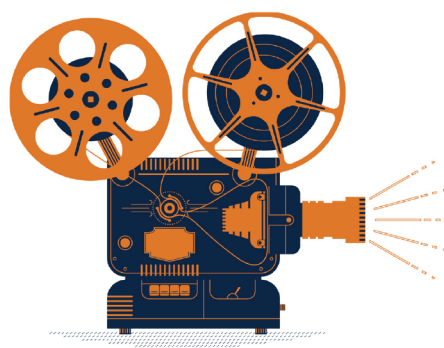
